Additionally, branded shuttles will be provided for the last pit-stop in Rome, where a **Drivalia stand** will be set up inside the Green Village.

Through this partnership with the Giro d'Italia, watched by 651 million people in 200 countries around the world, Drivalia strengthens its commitment to promoting sustainable mobility solutions in connection with sports events.
